

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ORGANISATIONS CONDUCTING SHOW

The ring numbers of all **winning** birds to be taken and submitted to the Union Secretary for verification of registration of ownership not later than one week form the date of the show.

Only SU rings can be verified by the SHU, all other rings must be verified through the appropriate Unions.

<u>In flown classes</u> competitors must submit to the organisers of the show, within 10 days from the date of the show, a certificate signed by two officials of their Club or Organisation, certifying that the winning bird has flown the required distance.

After verification of ring numbers and examination of flown certificates, the President or Secretary of the organisation will submit to the Union Secretary, <u>within four weeks of the date of the show</u>, a signed statement of their findings and decisions. If disqualifications are made, then a corrected result must be published with new prize winners. <u>Where a series of shows take place, returns must be sent weekly</u>
